Swimming Pool and Spa built/installed with a Pool fence and for Swimming Pool and Spa built/installed after 1 July 2010		
The outside of the pool fence is at least 1200mm high all the way around	Yes	No
If a boundary fence forms part of the pool fence; <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For pools built <i>before</i> 1 September 2008 - it must be at least 1200mm high • For pool built <i>after</i> 1 September 2008 – it must be at least 1800mm high 	Yes	No
The gap between the bottom of the fence and the ground is no more than 100mm	Yes	No
All vertical or near-vertical rails on the fence and gate are less than 100mm apart	Yes	No
There are no potential hand holds or foot holds within 900mm of the top of the pool fence in any direction.	Yes	No
If perforated or mesh fencing is used, the holes are 13mm or less	Yes	No
The pool fence is well-maintained and in a good state of repair (eg, it has no holes, broken rails or palings)	Yes	No
The gate swings freely, and closes and latches by itself from any position	Yes	No
The gate latch is working well so that the gate is secure and, once closed, can't be pulled open	Yes	No
The gate opens outwards, away from the pool area	Yes	No
The release for the gate latch must be 1500mm above ground level, or The release for the gate latch must be located on the inside of the fence and be surrounded by a 450mm shield so that it must be accessed by reaching over the fence or through a latch access point that is 1200mm above ground level.
